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# **About This Report**

The 2024 Joint Accreditation™ Data Report presents a comprehensive overview of the continuing education activities, learners, and outcomes reported by organizations accredited through Joint Accreditation for Interprofessional Continuing Education™. This annual report is based on data submitted by 187 jointly accredited providers for educational activities that took place in 2024.

Now in its seventh edition, the report reflects the ongoing evolution and growing impact of the interprofessional continuing education (IPCE) enterprise. It offers insights into the size and scope of the system, highlighting how jointly accredited organizations are delivering high-quality, independent education that supports team-based care, improves healthcare quality, and advances community health.

The data are self-reported by jointly accredited organizations using the Joint Accreditation Program and Activity Reporting System (JA-PARS). The data was reviewed for accuracy and completeness. All monetary values are reported in U.S. dollars.

#### What's Included:

- Aggregate statistics on the number of activities, learner interactions, and hours of instruction.
- Breakdowns by activity type, profession, and support/funding model.
- Trends in commercial support, registration fees, and advertising/exhibit income.
- Insights into performance and outcomes measurement.

Joint Accreditation is a collaboration of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME), the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), and the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC). It offers a unified pathway for organizations to deliver accredited continuing education planned by the healthcare team for the healthcare team.

As we share the 2024 Joint Accreditation Data Report, we continue to be inspired by the impact of our community and the evolution of the interprofessional continuing education (IPCE) enterprise. In 2024, jointly accredited organizations delivered 123,175 educational activities, engaging nearly 34 million learners across a wide range of health professions. 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

#### **OVERVIEW**

The 2024 Joint Accreditation Data Report provides a comprehensive snapshot of the interprofessional continuing education (IPCE) system. Based on data submitted by 187 jointly accredited organizations, the report offers insights into trends in activity volume, learner engagement, funding, and content delivery across the IPCE ecosystem.

# CE Presented by Jointly Accredited Providers Figure 1. Activities and Interactions 2018-2024




In 2024, the decrease in the number of learner interactions can be attributed primarily to changes in reporting by a few large providers, not an overall downward trend. The overall number of activities continued on an upward trajectory in 2024.


#### **KEY FINDINGS AND TRENDS**

#### Expanding Reach and Engagement

In 2024, jointly accredited providers offered 123,175 activities, an increase from 2023, reflecting continued growth in educational delivery. These activities engaged a wide spectrum of health professionals, supporting both individual development and team-based learning. The largest number of credits available were AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™ for physicians, followed by ANCC contact hours for nurses, and Interprofessional Continuing Education (IPCE) credits for the team.

The number of IPCE credits available has increased 33 percent since 2021.

#### Learner Engagement Across the Professions


In 2024, jointly accredited activities supported nearly 34 million learner interactions across a broad range of health professions. The highest participation came from nurses (11.8 million), physicians (8.9 million), and pharmacists/pharmacy technicians (5.1 million). Notably, the data reflects strong engagement from other healthcare team members, with more than 8 million learner interactions attributed to dentists, psychologists, optometrists, physician associates, social workers, dieticians, athletic trainers, and other health professions—demonstrating the inclusive reach and interprofessional strength of the jointly accredited system. Although total learner interactions declined slightly from 2023, this was largely due to changes in the CE programs of a few large providers and is not indicative of a broader trend.

### Diverse and Sustainable Funding Models


Jointly accredited organizations reported more than \$1 billion in income received from external sources. In 2024, providers reported the end of several large grants from government and private sectors that existed in 2023. Increases in registration fees and income from advertising exhibits compensated for these declines in grant funding.

#### **Educational Formats**

The most common educational formats were:

- Live courses: 60,681 activities
- Enduring materials: 52,130 activities
- Regularly Scheduled Series: 9,134 activities
- Blended learning, journal CME/CE, and performance improvement activities, among others, made up the remainder.



### Expanding Higher Level Outcome Measurement

Accredited activities are required to evaluate one or more learner/team competence, performance or patient outcomes. Most activities are measured against multiple levels of outcomes. As shown below, jointly accredited providers have the reach and ability through team-based education to push toward higher-level outcomes – at the performance and patient/community/population health levels.

<sup>2</sup>Joint Accreditation recategorized provider types for greater clarity, reducing reliance on "other" or "not classified" categories to better reflect the ecosystem's structure. Definitions are listed below:

Publishing/Education Company: Organizations that develop and distribute healthcare-related educational content, tools, or resources.

Hospital/Healthcare Delivery System: Organizations that directly provide medical care, including hospitals, clinics, physician groups, and integrated health systems operating across multiple care settings.

School of Health Sciences/Medicine: Academic institutions that educate and train healthcare professionals, including physicians, nurses, and other clinical practitioners.

Professional Membership Organization: Organizations that represent healthcare professionals and focus on the professional development of their members.

Government or Military: Public agencies that provide, fund, or oversee healthcare services at the federal, state, or local level, including branches of the military.

Voluntary Health Organization: Independent, primarily donation-funded organizations that focus on health-related research, disease prevention, health education, and/or patient services.

Other: Organizations eligible for accreditation that do not fit into the categories above, such as healthcare consulting firms, staffing agencies, or private regulatory bodies.

Insurance Company/Managed Care Company: Entities that offer health or liability insurance, collect premiums, maintain claims data, and reimburse healthcare services based on policy terms.




